Rule 15.21.2 Machine Requirements

Current Rule:

15.21.2 Machine Requirements

15.21.2.1 Engines:

- a) Must be 250cc and 350cc,
- b) Carburettor size 34mm +/- 0.1mm,
- c) Aftermarket parts may be used, however parts must be the same size as factory fitted parts,
- d) Use of Titanium is not permitted.

New Rule:

Remove existing rule.

Rationale:

Removal of this rule will bring MA's regulations more in line with the FIM's regulations for these classes of Speedway, and allow competitors wishing to race overseas in these classes to have engines for use in Australia and internationally.

Section a) & b) are already covered in rule 15.17.3 and parts c) & d) don't really save competitors costs.

Currently for riders to be competitive overseas they would require a different engine or engines to do so.
