OFFICIALS

Gaining accreditation as an Official is now easier than ever! The Officials Accreditation Scheme has been updated with a view to educate and accredit an increased number of volunteers. The General Seminar is now available as an online presentation meaning you can take the short assessment and complete your application online at home. After successful completion of the short assessment which follows the online presentation, applicants will be eligible for a Level 1 Operational Officials License. This accreditation allows you to officiate at club level events as an operational Official. Operational Officials include Flag marshals, Observers, Timekeepers, Judges, and Starters etc.

Once you have achieved the accreditation through the successful completion of the online General Seminar you can then precede onto accreditation as a Key Official (Scrutineer, Race Secretary, and Clerk of Course & Steward).

19.17.1.5 [Effective 1st October 2015] Only FIM homologated exhaust with heat shield fitted to be used.

This week's race face is:

Bob McGlinchy

An avid trials enthusiast and Motorcycling NSW Service Star recipient, we asked Bob what drew him to the sport and what keeps him involved these days.

How long have you been competing? I started riding Trials in 1977 when I was 29 years old, my bike was a 1976 model.

What drew you to Trials originally? The interest sparked through my brother who had a Trials bike, but he didn't have a drivers licence so I used to drive him around and thought I'd give it a go since I was going to be there anyway.

Do your children ride? My son did ride Trials for a while (fully sponsored by dad), but he wasn't that interested in it so we gave him the sack.

What Club/s are you a member of? Bankstown Wiley Park (Life Member since 1986), the Trials Club of Canberra, Wollongong MCC and Macarthur DMCC.

What is the highest level of event that you have competed at? I realised from the onset that I wasn't up to A Grade status, but I did manage to get up to B Grade.

You're also an official, what made you want to gain your accreditation? I became an official 1975 when I joined the Bankstown Wiley Park Motorcycle Club. I then eventually became a level 3 official and then was one of the first level 4 officials in the Country when MA introduced level 4. I had an FIM Steward and Clerk of Course accreditation for both Road Race and Trials, and was the Australian representative on the Jury at the last World Championship held in Australia two years ago.

What about your highlights as an official? In 1988 I was the Chief Flag Marshal at the final ACU Bathurst meeting. I was the senior communicator for all of the Sydney GP's and have been both Steward and Clerk of Course at Stadium Trials and Australian Championship level Supercross and Trials events.

Tell us about your experience with being involved with Committees and Boards? I was the NSW Trials administrator for Motorcycling NSW for many years as well as being on the actual Committee and an MA Commissioner for the last 5 years. I have been a Director on the MNSW Properties Board since Properties started and have been the Chairman of that board for the last couple of years.
