OFFICIALS

Gaining accreditation as an Official is now easier than ever! The Officials Accreditation Scheme has been updated with a view to educate and accredit an increased number of volunteers. The General Seminar is now available as an online presentation meaning you can take the short assessment and complete your application online at home. After successful completion of the short assessment which follows the online presentation, applicants will be eligible for a Level 1 Operational Officials License. This accreditation allows you to officiate at club level events as an operational Official. Operational Officials include Flag marshals, Observers, Timekeepers, Judges, and Starters etc.

Once you have achieved the accreditation through the successful completion of the online General Seminar you can then precede onto accreditation as a Key Official (Scrutineer, Race Secretary, and Clerk of Course & Steward).

Important Information Regarding Junior Enduro Competition

There seems to be some confusion surrounding the ages and bike capacities that junior riders can participate on for enduro events. Hopefully we will be able to clear some of this confusion.

- Riders aged 4-U9 - 50cc Demo Machines: These riders may only participate on a track licenced for Mini Enduro that does not exceed 500 metres in length.
- Riders aged 7-U9 - 50cc Auto Machines: These riders may only participate on a track licenced for Mini Enduro that does not exceed 500 metres in length
- Riders aged 7-U13 - 65cc Miniwheel Solo Machines: These riders may only participate on a track licenced for Mini Enduro that does not exceed 5000 metres in length. There are restrictions that must be adhered to by the club.
- Riders aged 9 and above - From 80cc and higher: These riders may participate on a track licenced for Enduro there are no restrictions to the length of the track.

As all members would be aware, Motorcycling NSW are in the process of implementing the Ridernet system for online licensing. Of late, we have received enquiries from officials who are also competitors querying the accreditations that appear on their competition licence. We wish to confirm that for the short term, two licenses may need to be carried by those who hold a competition and officials/coaches licence owing to two databases running in tandem. Once all of the officials and coaches accreditations can be added into and updated within the Ridernet system this process will revert back to the one single card. Please maintain both in the short term.

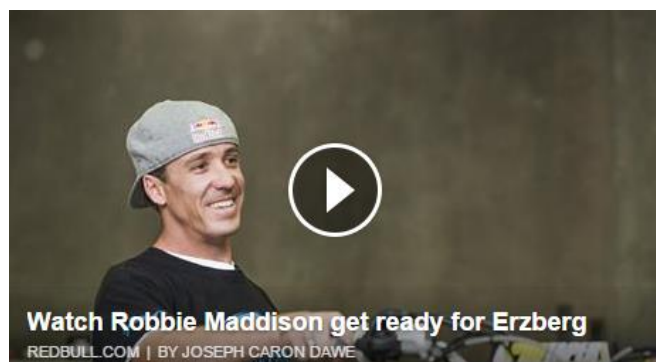
[Injury Reports](#)

Recently, Motorcycling NSW has received a number of incomplete injury reports returned to the office. We would like to take this opportunity to remind all of our Clubs and officials of the importance of fully and accurately completing this paperwork. Further, we advise that injury reports that are returned to the office which are incomplete will automatically result in the rider being noted on the medical suspension list regardless of the apparent injury, and will require a medical clearance prior to that member being allowed to re-commence participation. In addition to the above, the correspondence forwarded to the rider will note that their injury report was returned incomplete and they will be directed to address the Club or official with their concerns regarding the return of that correspondence.
