(a) <u>Starting Procedure</u> Accelerate at speed from the starting position, straight and in control, without breaking the tapes or jumping the start.	<input type="checkbox"/>
(b) <u>Cornering</u> Negotiate a corner at an acceptable speed equivalent to race standards smoothly and safely and maintain a constant line.	<input type="checkbox"/>
(c) <u>Lay-down/Evasive Action</u> ➤ Solo riders should demonstrate their ability to lay their bike down in a given distance without endangering the rider nor separating from the bike in the process. ➤ Sidecar riders are required to take evasive action when indicated without endangering themselves or their passenger and without separating from their machine in the process.	<input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/>
(d) <u>Sidecar Passengers</u> Are required to demonstrate the functions of a Sidecar Passenger whilst starting from the gate and whilst cornering at racing speed in a satisfactory manner.	<input type="checkbox"/>
